Safety Standards Commissioner-Elect

The Lifesaving Society Canada is currently seeking a volunteer to assist in leading the Safety Standards activity centre and projects as per the Lifesaving Society Canada (the 'Society' or 'LSC') strategic plan.

Working with the Safety Standards Commissioner, the Commissioner-Elect will perform duties as outlined in the Safety Standards Terms of Reference and Safety Standards Commissioner Job Description. The successful applicant will fill the role of Safety Standards Commissioner-Elect for one year, Safety Standards Commissioner for two years and Past-Commissioner for one year (totalling 4 years).

The Lifesaving Society Canada's Safety Standards Commission contributes to the mission of the Society by setting evidence-based standards and best practices to prevent drowning and water-related injuries; and to optimize safety in, on and around aquatic environments. At this time, the Safety Standards Commission has three areas of focus to help achieve this mandate:

- Develop four (4) research-based standards annually based on industry and/or stakeholder needs.
- Revise six (6) existing standards annually based on a five-year review from the BOD date of approval.
- Work with the Branches to leverage Canada's aquatic safety standards positioning to the benefit of the Society and its programs, activities and services.
